CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to certify, That MORRIS C. AND FAY M. RISINGER

of 8465 E. Antelope Road, Eagle Point, State of OR 97524, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Antelope Creek

a tributary of Little Butte Creek for the purpose of irrigation of 4.0 acres

under Permit No. 10768 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 12, 1932

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.05 cubic foot per second, if available at the original point of diversion; NW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 15, T37S, R1E, WM; 1200 feet South and 2300 feet West from E 1/4 corner Section 15.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 15, T37S, R1E, WM; 720 feet North and 950 feet East from W 1/4 corner Section 15.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, during the irrigation season from April 1 to November 1 of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

4.0 acres SW 1/4 NW 1/4
Section 15
Township 37 South, Range 1 East, WM

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered January 8, 1973, and together with certificate of water right recorded at page 45048, Volume 37, State Record of Water Right Certificates, supersedes certificate 10765.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
