CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to certify, That ASHTON FOERST

of 16190 Highway 238, Grants Pass, State of OR 97526, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Applegate Lake Reservoir constructed under Permit R-7810

a tributary of Applegate River for the purpose of supplemental irrigation of 41.2 acres

under Permit No. 45892 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 20, 1981 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 40 acre-feet stored water only

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 25, T38S, R4W, WM; New Bergman Ditch - 1050 feet South and 500 feet West from N 1/4 corner Section 25. (Applegate Dam - S 1/2 SE 1/4, Section 25, T40S, R4W, WM)

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second per acre, _____ a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and is subject to the terms and conditions of Contract 1-07-10-W0325 between the Bureau of Reclamation and the applicant, or a satisfactory replacement, a copy of which is on file in the records of the Water Resources Director,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

2.5 acres SW 1/4 NW 1/4
15.2 acres NW 1/4 SW 1/4
Section 17

14.2 acres SE 1/4 NE 1/4
9.3 acres NE 1/4 SE 1/4
Section 18

Township 38 South, Range 4 West, WM

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
