CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to certify, That

of PO Box 85, Shady Cove, State of OR 97539, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Applegate River

a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of gravel washing

under Permit No. 27402 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 11, 1961 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.42 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 19, T36S, R6W, WM; 1370 feet North and 4930 feet East from SW corner Section 19.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre, use during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right to the use of water is limited to the period when the flow of the Rogue River is more than 735 cfs at its mouth,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4
Section 19
Township 36 South, Range 6 West, WM

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in use of water approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered September 30, 1977, and together with certificate of water right recorded at page 45061, Volume 37, State Record of Water Right Certificates, supersedes certificate 34043.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
