CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

MINERVA TOPPING

of Williams, State of OR 97544, has a right to the use of the waters of Williams Creek

a tributary of Applegate River for the purpose of irrigation of 23.0 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 4, at page 1; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1858 for Tract 1 and 1892 for Tract 2

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.38 cubic foot per second

The point of diversion is located in the SW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 12, T38S, R5W, WM; Watts-Topping Ditch - 460 feet North and 90 feet East from SW corner, Section 12 for Tract 1; SW 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 1, T38S, R5W, WM; Laurel Hill Ditch - 95 feet North and 2190 feet West from E 1/4 corner, Section 1 for\* A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

18.0 acres SE 1/4 SW 1/4

TRACT 2

5.0 acres SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 35 Township 37 South, Range 5 West, WM

This certificate is issued to correctly describe the dates of priority and supersedes certificate of water right recorded at page 46879, Volume 39, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
