CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For Rights which have been confirmed by the Courts)

This is to Certify, That JOHN T. FAULKNER of Paulina State of Oregon has a right to the use of the waters of Alkalie and Beaver Creeks, tributary to Crooked River,

for the purpose of the irrigation of 110 acres of land and domestic and stock use,

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Crook County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 1, at page 449 ; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from the year 1909 for the irrigation of Tract No. 1 from Alkalie Creek; and from 1891 for the irrigation of Tract No. 2, from Beaver Creek;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed a reasonable amount for domestic and stock use, and 1.36 cubic feet per second from July 1st to September 15th of each year, for irrigation.

The use hereunder shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:

70 acres in Tract No. 1, located as follows: 30 acres in the SW 1/4 of SE 1/4; 40 acres in the SE 1/4 of SE 1/4; Section Thirty-four (34), Township Sixteen (16) South Range Twenty-three (23) East of Willamette Meridian, in Crook County, Oregon.

40 acres in Tract No. 2, located as follows: 20 acres in the NE 1/4 of NE 1/4; 20 acres in the SE 1/4 of NE 1/4; Section Four (4) Township Seventeen (17) South Range Twenty-three (23) East of Willamette Meridian, in Crook County, Oregon.

Note: The limited irrigation system and water herein is in place and should conform to the system as defined in the Decree. See account book referred to Certificate 548.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
