CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to certify, That OREGON STATE HIGHWAY DIVISION

of PO Box 850, LaGrande, State of OR 97850, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Emigrant Springs State Park Well #2

a tributary of Squaw Creek (Umatilla River) for the purpose of Rest area usage at Deadmans Pass Safety Rest Area

under Permit No. G-6416 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 8, 1975 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.03 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the well. The well is located in the SW 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 29, T1N, R35E, WM; 10.4 feet North and 250.9 feet East from Center 1/4 corner Section 29.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

W 1/2 NE 1/4
NE 1/4 NW 1/4
Section 1
Township 1 North, Range 34 East, WM

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
