CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That ELWOOD PIPER

of 824 S. Columbia, Milton-Freewater, State of OR 97862, has a right to the use of the waters of Walla Walla River

a tributary of Columbia River for the purpose of irrigation of 8.5 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1880

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one half miner's inches per acre measured at the point of diversion

The point of diversion is located in the SW 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 18, T5N, R36E, WM; Milton Ditch - 415 feet North and 65 feet East from W 1/4 corner Section 18.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- 3.0 acres NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 2
2.2 acres SE 1/4 NE 1/4
3.3 acres NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 3
Township 5 North, Range 35 East, WM

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered September 27, 1979, and together with certificate of water right recorded at page 48906, Volume 42, State Record of Water Right Certificates, supersedes certificate 12814.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
