## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That**

WILBUR AND DARLINE VANDERBECK

of 37717 S. Hwy. 213, Mt. Angel, State of OR 97362, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Butte Creek

a tributary of Pudding River for the purpose of irrigation of 23.5 acres

under Permit No. 13184 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 2, 1938 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.59 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE 1/4 SE 1/4, as projected within J. Jack DLC 41, Section 8, T6S, R1E, WM; 3390 feet South and 2100 feet West from the NE corner DLC 41.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
