## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to certify, That ORVEL D. HARRIS

of 11655 Williams Hwy., Grants Pass , State of OR 97526 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of a spring

a tributary of Applegate River for the purpose of domestic use for one family and supplemental irrigation of 0.5 acre

under Permit No. 43977 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 31, 1979

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed

0.015 cubic foot per second; being 0.005 cfs for domestic and 0.01 cfs for supplemental irrigation

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 35, T37S, R5W, WM; 450 feet North and 1200 feet West from C 1/4 corner Section 35.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

domestic & 0.5 acre SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 35 Township 37 South, Range 5 West, WM

In processing the application towards issuance of the permit, it appears that a clerical error was inadvertently made in limiting the duty of water to not exceed 2.5 acre feet per acre. In the issuance of this certificate, the duty of water has been raised to 4.5 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, in keeping with the customary policy and determination of this office of the proper maximum limits.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
