CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to certify, That FRED F. AND KEN H. VAN RADEN

of Route 5, Box 640, Hillsboro, State of OR 97123, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Rock Creek & Reservoir constructed under Permit R-6052

a tributary of Tualatin River for the purpose of recreation and fish culture

under Permit No. 37297 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 20, 1973 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.5 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 26, T2N, R2W, WM; 240 feet North and 800 feet West from SE corner SW 1/4 NW 1/4.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4
Section 26
SE 1/4 NE 1/4
Section 27
Township 2 North, Range 2 West, WM

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
