that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.13 cubic foot per second

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per existing for the same lands, shall be limited to or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;
