CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, *That* PETER R., RICHARD T., AND TIMOTHY R. RAWLINS

of PO Box 12628, Salem, State of OR 97309, has
a right to the use of the waters of Canyon Creek

a tributary of John Day River for the purpose of
irrigation of 41.1 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Grant County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 15, at page 461; that the priority of the
right thereby confirmed dates from 1873

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1/40 cubic foot
per second per acre irrigated to June 1 and 1/80 cubic foot per second
thereafter; further limited to one acre-foot per calendar month to June 1 and
four acre-feet per acre during season April 1 to September 30, measured at*

The point of diversion is located in the SW 1/4 NW 1/4, SE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 19,
T15S, R32E, WM; John A. Miller Ditches - 2050 feet South and 1950 feet East;
Diversion #1 - 1520 feet South and 1120 feet East; both from NW corner
Section 19; NE 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 24, T15S, R31E, WM; Diversion #2 - 400**
A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
follows:

*point of diversion, provided the quantity of water diverted at the new points
of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall
not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under
the subject right

This certificate is issued to confirm changes in points of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered January 28, 1983, and together with certificate of water right recorded at page 51442, Volume 46, State Record of Water Right Certificates, supersedes certificate 25026.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
