## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for

Wasco County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 7, at page 406; that the priority
of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1880

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed Three acre feet per acre in any irrigation season;

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Two and six tenths (2.6) acres in the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter ( $NW_2^1SW_4^2$ ) and Nine and two tenths (9.2) acres in the Northeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter ( $NE_2^1SW_2^2$ ) of Section Thirty-two (32), Township One (1) North of Range Fourteen (14) East of the Willamette Meridian, containing 11.8 acres.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
