CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

JAMES M. ANDERSON

of 16301 Hwy. 238, Grants Pass, State of OR 97527, has a right to the use of the waters of Applegate River

a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of irrigation of 3.6 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 16, at page 523; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1906

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.07 cubic foot per second, if available at the original point of diversion; NE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 25, T38S, R4W, W.M.

The point of diversion is located in the SE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 17, T38S, R4W, WM; Bridge Point Ditch - 220 feet North and 1080 feet West from SE corner Section 17.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

2.3 acres SW 1/4 NW 1/4
1.3 acres NW 1/4 SW 1/4
Section 17
Township 38 South, Range 4 West, WM

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered July 20, 1983, and together with certificate of water right recorded at page 52985, Volume 48, State Record of Water Right Certificates, supersedes certificate 32890.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
