CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That

H. E. CARLETON

of Dufur, State of Oregon ⁹⁷⁰²¹ has a right to the use of

the waters of Fifteen Mile Creek

for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Wasco County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 7, at page 406; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1860

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed Three acre feet per acre in any irrigation season;

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Twelve and two tenths (12.2) acres in the Southeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty-six (26); Thirty-two and three tenths (32.3) acres in the Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$) and Thirty-two and five tenths (32.5) acres in the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Thirty-five (35), Township One (1) South, Range Thirteen (13) East of the Willamette Meridian, being a total of 77 acres.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
