that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.434 cubic foot per second, subject to the provision of paragraph 33 of said decree, and all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The point of diversion is located in the NW4 SE4, Section 22, T1N, R32E, WM.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at page 2497, Volume 3, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on March 19, 1987.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
