## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That**RUSSMAR COMPANY, Jack Russell  
c/o Cascade Cattle Company

1155 S. Fk. Little Butte Creek Rd  
of Eagle Point, State of OR 97524, has made  
proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of  
Lost, Harrison, Charley & Coon Creeks, Frog Pond & Harrison Reservoirs,  
constructed under Permits R-4950, R-4951  
a tributary of South Fork Little Butte Creek for the purpose of  
supplemental irrigation of 139.8 acres

under Permit No. 32304 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in  
accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from  
May 18, 1967

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes  
aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed  
0.35 cubic foot per second; being 0.21 cfs from Lost Creek; 0.05 cfs from  
Harrison Creek; 0.05 cfs from Charley Creek; 0.04 cfs from Coon Creek & 284.0  
acre-feet from Harrison & Frog Pond Reservoirs

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.  
The point of diversion is located in the SE 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 1, T37S, R1E, WM;  
SW 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 27, NE 1/4 NE 1/4, NE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 28, SE 1/4  
NE 1/4, Section 20, T37S, R2E, WM; Frog Pond & Harrison Reservoirs - 710 feet  
North and 1460 feet East; 170 feet North and 2070 feet East; both from SW  
corner Section 1; Lost Creek - 1650 feet South and 2650 feet East; Harrison\*

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other  
right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second  
per acre,

or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct  
flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5  
acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of  
each year from direct flow and storage, and further limited to the use of  
stored water only on the lands described as supplemental,

and shall  
conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right  
is appurtenant, is as follows:

\*Creek - 980 feet South and 450 feet West; both from NW corner Section 27;  
Charley Creek - 50 feet South and 850 feet West from N 1/4 corner Section 28;  
Coon Creek - 400 feet North from E 1/4 corner Section 20, T37S, R2E, WM
