CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

of Route 2, Box 90, John Day , State of OR 97845 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of John Day River

a tributary of Columbia River for the purpose of irrigation of 11.0 acres and supplemental irrigation of 56.0 acres

under Permit No. 8655 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 24, 1928

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.04 cubic foot per second, if available at the original point of diversion; NW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 13, T13S, R32E, WM; 2300 feet North and 700 feet East from SW corner Section 3.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 14, T13S, R32E, WM; 2040 feet North and 2020 feet East from SW corner Section 14.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth one cubic foot per second per acre,

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
