CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That LORAIN J. AND THELMA D. FRICKEY

of HCR 56, Box 541, John Day, State of OR 97845, has a right to the use of the waters of Laycock Creek

a tributary of John Day River for the purpose of irrigation of 13.2 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Grant County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 15, at page 461; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1866

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1/40 cubic foot per second per acre irrigated to June 1 and 1/80 cubic foot per second per acre thereafter; further limited to one acre-foot per calendar month to June 1 and four acre-feet per acre during season April 1 to September 30, if \*

The point of diversion is located in the NE 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 36, T13S, R30E, WM; 280 feet South and 250 feet West, 1280 feet South and 240 feet West both from NE corner Section 36.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

\* available at the original points of diversion; NW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 31, T13S, R31E, WM; 90 feet South and 89 feet East from E 1/4 corner Section 36, SE 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 36, T13S, R30E, WM; 1370 feet South and 220 feet West from NE corner Section 36.

5.4 acres SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 25

0.3 acre SE 1/4 NE 1/4 7.5 acres NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 36

Township 13 South, Range 30 East, WM

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered November 23, 1982, and together with certificate of water right recorded at page 52029, Volume 47, State Record of Water Right Certificates, supersedes certificate 25909.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
