CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

HAROLD L. AND HAZEL E. WILSON

of 332 Covered Bridge Road, Rogue River, State of OR 97537, has a right to the use of the waters of Evans Creek

a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of irrigation of 6.9 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 16, at page 523; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1902

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.11 cubic foot per second, if available at the original point of diversion in the SE 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 11, T35S, R4W, WM; Vroman Ditch - 1200 feet North and 100 feet West from E 1/4 corner Section 11.

The point of diversion is located in the NW 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 15, T35S, R4W, WM; 180 feet South and 1630 feet West from NE corner Section 15

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

6.1 acres NE 1/4 NE 1/4
0.8 acre NW 1/4 NE 1/4
Section 15
Township 35 South, Range 4 West, WM

being within the following described tract:

Beginning at a point on the North line of Section 15, T35S, R4W, WM, which is 708 feet West of the NE corner thereof, thence South 419.5 feet; thence North 83 degrees 15 minutes West to the Center of Evans Creek; thence in a North-easterly direction along said Creek to the North line of Section 15, thence East to the point of beginning.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered October 11, 1978, and together with certificate of water right recorded at page 46876, Volume 39, State Record of Water Right Certificates, supersedes certificate 42160.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
