CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**This is to certify, That**WILLIAM D. AND H. JOAN PETERSON,
FREDERICK T. AND VIRGINIA L. BLAKELY,
AND JOYCE WAY

of 4888 Lower Graves Crk Rd., Sunny Valley, State of OR 97478, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of two unnamed streams, and a spring

a tributary of Graves Creek for the purpose of domestic use for three families and irrigation of 9.9 acres

under Permit No. 40360 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 5, 1975

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.13 cubic foot per second; being 0.06 cfs from Stream #1, 0.06 cfs from Stream #2 for irrigation, and 0.01 cfs from Spring for domestic

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW 1/4 SE 1/4, NE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 31, NW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 32, T33S, R6W, WM; Diversion #1 - 1200 feet North and 1220 feet West; Spring - 1430 feet North and 90 feet West; Diversion #2 - 1400 feet North and 150 feet East all from SE corner Section 31.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

domestic & 1.2 acres SW 1/4 SE 1/4
7.4 acres SE 1/4 SE 1/4

domestic & 1.3 acres SE 1/4 SE 1/4

Township 33 South, Range 6 West, WM

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
