CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

ERNEST A. and HENRY L. KUCK, Successors in interest

This is to Certify, That/ ^{to} MRS. LOIS A. GILPIN

of The Dalles, State of Oregon has a right to the use of
 the waters of Eight Mile Creek, a tributary of Fifteen Mile Creek;
 for the purpose of Irrigation and stock;

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
 Wasco County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
 Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 7, at page 406; that the priority
 of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1896

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
 amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed Three acre feet per
 acre in any irrigation season, and one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second for
 each one thousand head of stock;

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant
 (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

One (1) acre in the the Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$) and One
 and seven tenths (1.7) acres in the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter
 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty-two (22), Township One (1) North, Range Fourteen (14)
 East of the Willamette Meridian, being a total of 2.7 acres.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations
 contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place
 of use herein described.
