## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That**

JACK D. WELLINGTON

of Keating, State of Oregon 97814, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Powder River

a tributary of Snake River for the purpose of irrigation of 52.5 acres

under Permit No. 3672 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 15, 1917

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.66 cubic foot per second, if available at the original point of diversion; SE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 22, T8S, R42E, WM; South 27.25 chains and South 38 degrees 15 minutes West 5.75 chains from N 1/4 corner Section 22

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 34, T7S, R41E, WM; Irwin Canal - 1500 feet South and 270 feet West from N 1/4 corner Section 34.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
