CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to certify, That RICHARD CADDOCK

of 1606 Wild River Drive, Roseburg, State of OR 97470, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of North Umpqua River

a tributary of Umpqua River for the purpose of reservoir maintenance only during the irrigation season of each year

under Permit No. 14491 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 16, 1940

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.006 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW 1/4 SW 1/4, as projected within Wm. Trask DLC No. 40, Section 14, T26S, R4W, WM; 550 feet South and 1125 feet East from W 1/4 corner Section 14.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SW 1/4 as projected within Wm. Trask DLC No. 40
Section 14
Township 26 South, Range 4 West, WM

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in use approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered November 1, 1983, and together with certificate of water right recorded at page 51844, Volume 46, State Record of Water Right Certificates, supersedes certificate 20890.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
