CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to certify, That JAMES A. MORRIS

of Route 1, Box 81, Mt. Vernon, State of OR 97865, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of John Day River

a tributary of Columbia River for the purpose of irrigation of 3.0 acres

under Permit No. E-88 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 6, 1911

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.04 cubic foot per second, if available at Panama Ditch

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 28, T13S, R30E, WM; Lemons Ditch - 2900 feet North and 1660 feet East from SW corner Section 28.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

2.0 acres NW 1/4 NE 1/4
1.0 acre NE 1/4 NW 1/4
Section 29
Township 13 South, Range 30 East, WM

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered June 11, 1984, and together with certificate of water right recorded at page 52195, Volume 47, State Record of Water Right Certificates, supersedes certificate 46773.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
