## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This is to certify, That** JOHN AND JEAN DEBONA

of Route 1, Box 282, Mt. Vernon, State of OR 97865, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of John Day River

a tributary of Columbia River for the purpose of irrigation of 9.0 acres

under Permit No. 31774 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from

July 15, 1966

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed

0.225 cubic foot per second, if available at the original point of diversion, NW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 14, T13S, R28E, WM; 980 feet South and 1750 feet West from E 1/4 corner Section 14.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 14, T13S, R28E, WM; 490 feet South and 1660 feet West from the E 1/4 corner Section 14.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 5.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

9.0 acres NW 1/4 SE 1/4  
Section 14  
Township 13 South, Range 28 East, WM

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered February 22, 1983, and supersedes certificate of water right recorded at page 44291, Volume 36, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
