CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

JAMES H. AND LOTTIE L. MARTIN

of 7502 E. Evans Creek Rd., Rogue River, State of OR 97537, has a right to the use of the waters of Evans Creek

a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of stock and irrigation of 5.5 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 16, at page 523; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1902

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.09 cubic foot per second, if available at the original point of diversion; Vroman Ditch.

The point of diversion is located in the SE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 15, T35S, R4W, WM; 1650 feet South and 500 feet West from N 1/4 corner Section 15,

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

3.7 acres SW 1/4 NE 1/4
1.8 acres SE 1/4 NE 1/4
Section 15
Township 35 South, Range 4 West, WM

This certificate is issued to confirm changes in place of use and point of diversion approved by orders of the Water Resources Director entered May 23, 1983, and together with the cancellation order entered May 8, 1984 and transfers 5141, 5142 and 5247, supersedes certificate of water right recorded at page 32784, Volume 24, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
