CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

JAMES H AND LOTTIE L. MARTIN

of 7502 E. Evans Creek Road, Rogue River, State of OR 97537, has
 a right to the use of the waters of Evans Creek

a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of
 domestic, stock and irrigation of 54.0 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
 Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
 the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 16, at page 523; that the priority of the right
 thereby confirmed dates from 1902

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
 amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.90 cubic foot
 per second

The point of diversion is located in the SE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 15, T35S, R4W, WM;
 1650 feet South and 500 feet West from the N 1/4 corner Section 15.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
 follows:

4.4 acres in that part of NE 1/4 NE 1/4
 15.9 acres in that part of NW 1/4 NE 1/4
 lying East of Evans Creek
 South of the following-described line:

Beginning at a point 1,237.9 feet South of the NE corner of Section 15; thence
 North 75 degrees 45 minutes West 2,332 feet to the center of Evans Creek

28.2 acres SW 1/4 NE 1/4
 3.5 acres SE 1/4 NE 1/4
 2.0 acres in that part of NE 1/4 NW 1/4
 lying East of Evans Creek
 Section 15
 Township 35 South, Range 4 West, WM

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved
 by an order of the Water Resources Director entered April 10, 1980, and
 supersedes certificate of water right recorded at page 32785, Volume 24, State
 Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of
 the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to
 forfeiture or abandonment.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
 The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein
 described.
