CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That E. J. CAMERON

of Jacksonville, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of the waters of Little Applegate River

a tributary of Applegate River for the purpose of irrigation of 101.42 acres, domestic and stock use

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 4, at page 1; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1854

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 2.90 cubic feet per second

The point of diversion is located in the SW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 11, T39S, R3W, WM; Davidson Ditch - North 39 degrees 02 minutes East, 1184 feet from S 1/4 corner Section 11.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at page 16391, Volume 13, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on October 14, 1986, approving transfer application No. 5832.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
