CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

HUGH H. WHITE, SHARLET SLACK, J. E.
FRANKLIN, CHARLES W. BUCK, WM. E.
MARTINDALE, AND MRS. ARTHUR KELLERT,
by A. Buck, Secretary

of Star Route, Kerby, State of Oregon, has made
proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of
East Fork Illinois River

a tributary of Illinois River for the purpose of
irrigation of 15.75 acres

under Permit No. 13140 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in
accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from
May 16, 1938
that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes
aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed
0.32 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.
The point of diversion is located in the NW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 27, T39S, R8W, W.W.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other
right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fiftieth of one cubic foot per second
per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated throughout
the irrigation season from April 1 to November 1 of each year,

and shall
conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right
is appurtenant, is as follows:

5.00 acres SW 1/4 SE 1/4 (White)

Township 38 South, Range 8 West, WM

5.00 acres NW 1/4 NE 1/4 (Franklin)
1.00 acre NW 1/4 SE 1/4 (Kellert)
1.00 acre NW 1/4 SE 1/4 (Martindale)
Section 4
Township 39 South, Range 8 West, WM

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at page 14429, Volume 12, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on July 27, 1987, approving transfer application No. 5890.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described. and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
