CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

LUCIUS ROBINSON

of Kerby, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of the waters of East Fork Illinois River

a tributary of irrigation of 66.7 acres for the purpose of

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Josephine County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 13, at page 70; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from May 1887

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one cubic foot per second for each 50 acres of land irrigated during the irrigation season from April 1 to November 1 of each year,

The point of diversion is located in the SE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 27, T39S, R8W, WM - Kerbyville Milling & Irrigation Company Ditch for tract 1 & SE 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 33, T38S, R8W, WM - 670 feet North and 1560 feet East from SW corner Section 33 for tract 2.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at page 13904, Volume 12, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on July 27, 1987, approving transfer application No. 5890.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
