CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

EMIL W. MAAG

of Route 2, Box 186, Vale, Malheur County, Oregon, State of OR 97918, has
 a right to the use of the waters of Willow Creek

a tributary of Malheur River for the purpose of
 irrigation of 109.0 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Malheur County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 3, at page 258; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from Tract #1 - 1871 for 50.0 acres and Tract #2 - 1873 for 59.0 acres

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed a rate of flow of 2.73 second foot from February 15th to May 1st and 1.37 second foot from May 1st to September 1st of each year, or the equivalent in case of rotation; the total quantity diverted during each irrigation season not to exceed 327.0 acre feet, if available at the original point of diversion, Hammack Ditch

The point of diversion is located in the NE 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 9, T16S, R43E, WM; 30 feet South and 1240 feet West from NE corner Section 9.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

TRACT 1

19.0 acres NE 1/4 SE 1/4
 31.0 acres SE 1/4 SE 1/4

TRACT 2

36.0 acres NW 1/4 SE 1/4
 14.0 acres SW 1/4 SE 1/4
 9.0 acres SE 1/4 SE 1/4

Section 10
 Township 16 South, Range 43 East, WM

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered August 22, 1980, and together with certificate of water right recorded at page 49718, Volume 43, State Record of Water Right Certificates, supersedes certificate 1607.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
