CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

CITY OF DUFUR, SUCCESSOR TO:  
ADALINE L. KESSLER

This is to Certify, That

of The Dalles, State of Oregon has a right to the use of  
the waters of Fifteen Mile Creek  
for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for  
Wasco County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order  
Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 7, at page 406; that the priority  
of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1906

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an  
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed Three acre feet per  
acre in any irrigation season;

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant  
(or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Five tenths (0.5) acre in the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ )  
and Three and six tenths (3.6) acres in the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast  
Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Fifteen (15), Township Two (2) South, Range Twelve (12)  
East of the Willamette Meridian, being a total of 4.1 acres.

of the State Engineer, of 1929

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations  
contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place  
of use herein described.
