CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to certify, ThatBURTON ANDERSON, ALLEN CLARK AND
HARRY S. SWANSON

of PO Box 86, Cascade Locks, State of OR 97014, has made
proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of
Middle Oxbow Spring (Little Hermon Creek)

a tributary of Columbia River for the purpose of
domestic use for 4 homesites and a trailer park, and irrigation of 4.6 acres

under Permit No. 77 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in
accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from
August 10, 1909

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is
limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed

0.10 cubic foot per second; being 0.04 cfs for domestic; 0.035 cfs in trailer
park; 0.004 cfs for 3 Clark sites and 0.001 cfs for Swanson site; and 0.06 cfs
for irrigation

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of
diversion is located in the NE 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 7, T2N, R8E, WM; 740
feet South and 120 feet West from NE corner, Section 7.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right
existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eighthieth of one cubic foot per second per
acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is
appurtenant, is as follows:

Trailer Park SW 1/4 SE 1/4
Trailer park, 4 domestics, and 4.6 acres SE 1/4 SE 1/4
Section 6
Township 2 North, Range 8 East, WM

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use and point of
diversion approved by an order of the State Engineer entered April 22, 1930,
and together with certificate of water right recorded at page 56519,
Volume 52, State Record of Water Right Certificates, supersedes certificate
715.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of
the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to
forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use
herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an
effective date prior to this right.
