CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

OREGON DEPARTMENT OF FISH & WILDLIFE

of 506 SW Mill Street, Portland , State of OR 97201 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Middle & East Oxbow Springs and Little Hermon Creek

a tributary of Columbia River for the purpose of domestic use in 5 houses, irrigation of 3.1 acres, and use in a fish hatchery

under Permit No. 77 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 10, 1909

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.04 cubic foot per second from Middle Oxbow Spring for domestic, 0.04 cfs from Middle & East Oxbow Springs for irrigation, and 8.82 cfs from Little Hermon Creek for hatchery use

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE 1/4, Section 7, NW 1/4, NW 1/4, Section 8, T2N, R8E, WM; Middle Oxbow Spring - 740 feet South and 120 feet West; East Oxbow Spring - 590 feet South and 50 feet East; Little Herman Creek- 400 feet South and 10 feet East; all from NW corner of Section 8.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to per acre,

one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

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Domestic SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 6 2 domestic & 1.8 acres NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 7

2 domestic, fish hatchery, 1.3 acres NW 1/4 NW 1/4
Section 8
Township 2 North, Range 8 East, WM

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use and point of diversion approved by an order of the State Engineer entered April 22, 1930, and together with certificate of water right recorded at page 56518, Volume 52, State Record of Water Right Certificates, supersedes certificate 715.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
