CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That THOMAS B. LEABO

of Dufur, State of Oregon has a right to the use of the waters of Eight Mile Creek, a tributary of Fifteen Mile Creek; for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Wasco County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 7, at page 406; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1880

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed Three acre feet per acre in any irrigation season;

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Four and forty-one hundredths (4.41) acres in the Northeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (NE 1/4 SW 1/4); forty hundredths (0.40) acre in the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (NW 1/4 SW 1/4); Eighty-three hundredths (0.83) acre in the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (SW 1/4 SW 1/4) and thirty-seven hundredths (0.37) acre in the Southeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (SE 1/4 SW 1/4) of Section Eleven (11), Township One (1) South, Range Thirteen (13) East of the Willamette Meridian, being a total of 6.01 acres.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
