CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS IS TO CERTIFY, that

COW CREEK BAND OF UMPQUA TRIBE OF INDIANS
of 1376 NE WALNUT, SUITE I ROSEBURG OR 97470
has a right to the use of the waters of CANYON CREEK
a tributary of SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER for the purpose of
IRRIGATION.

The right has been perfected under Permit 38860. The
date of priority is NOVEMBER 16, 1973. The right is limited to
not more than 0.310 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in
case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the
source. The point of diversion is located in the

DLC 51, NE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 27, T 30 S, R 05 W, WM;
280 FEET SOUTH & 1400 FEET EAST FROM NW CORNER, SECTION 27

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the
amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands,
shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per
acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further
limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for
each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system
as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to
which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is
restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water
Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
