CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS IS TO CERTIFY, that

LORAIN J. FRICKEY
THELMA D. FRICKEY
of HCR 56, BOX 541 JOHN DAY OR 97845
has a right to the use of the waters of LAYCOCK CREEK
a tributary of JOHN DAY RIVER for the purpose of
IRRIGATION.

The right has been perfected under Permit 47117. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 23, 1982. The right is limited to not more than 0.330 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source. The point of diversion is located in the

(point 1) NE 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 36, T 13 S, R 30 E, WM;
1280 FEET SOUTH & 240 FEET WEST FROM NE CORNER SECTION 36
(point 2) NE 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 36, T 13 S, R 30 E, WM;
280 FEET SOUTH & 250 FEET WEST FROM NE CORNER SECTION 36

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
