CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS IS TO CERTIFY, that

USDA, FOREST SERVICE  
of 139 NE DAYTON ST JOHN DAY OR 97845  
has a right to the use of the waters of MCALLISTER SPRING  
a tributary of BLACK CANYON CREEK for the purpose of  
LIVESTOCK.

The right has been perfected under Permit 44157. The  
date of priority is APRIL 9, 1979. The right is limited to  
not more than 0.005 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in  
case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the  
source. The point of diversion is located in the

NE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 3, T 17 S, R 34 E, WM;  
836 FEET SOUTH & 924 FEET WEST FROM E 1/4 CORNER SECTION 3

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system  
as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to  
which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

	1/4 1/4	SECTION TOWNSHIP RANGE, WM
LIVESTOCK	NE SE	3 17 S 34 E

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is  
restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.  
The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water  
Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
