CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That MRS. E. A. UNDERHILL

of Dufur, State of Oregon has a right to the use of

the waters of Fifteen Mile Creek

for the purpose of Domestic and Stock

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Wasco County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 7, at page 406; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1896

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed One-fortieth of one cubic foot per second for each one thousand head of stock, and a reasonable amount for domestic purposes;

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Place of Use: The Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Fourteen (14), and the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Eleven (11), Township Two (2) South, Range Twelve (12) East of the Willamette Meridian.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
