and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for

Wasoo County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order

Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 8, at page 119; that the priority
of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1859

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed One-sixtieth of a cubic foot per second per acre during the irrigation season from April 1st to October 1st;

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Five and eight tenths (5.8) acres in the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SE $_4^2$ SE $_4^2$) and Three tenths (0.3) acres in the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SW $_4^2$ SE $_4^2$) of Section Five (5); Six and four tenths (6.4) acres in the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (NE $_4^2$ NE $_3^2$) and Fifteen and eight tenths (15.8) acres in the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (NW $_4^2$ NE $_3^2$) of Section Eight (8). Township One (1) North. Range Thirteen (13) East of the Willamette Meridian, being a total of 28.3 acres.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
