CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That MRS. IDA MEYER, widow, & ALGERNON R., adult son, and three minor children (Heirs of Henry Meyer)
of The Dalles , State of Oregon has a right to the use of

the waters of Mill Creek, and spring located in SW2SW2, Sec.4. T. 1 N.R.13 E.W.M.. used for domestic purposes in SE2SE2. Section 5, T. 1 N. R. 13 E.W.M. for the purpose of Irrigation and domestic:

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for wasco County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 8, at page 119; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1863 for Irrigation, and 1908 for domestic use;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed One-sixtieth of a cubic foot per second per sore during the irrigation season from April 1st to October 1st, and a reasonable smount for domestic purposes;

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Seven (7) agrees in the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (SW $_4$ SW $_4$) of Section Four (4), and Four and seven tenths (4.7) agrees in the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SP $_2$ SE $_4$) of Section Five (5). Township One (1) North, Range Thirteen (13) East of the Willamette Meridian, being a total of 11.7 agrees.

Oh. Pt of Div. & Place of Use for all hands: 5p.Or Vol. 12,p62

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
