CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That GEORGE MILLER

of The Dalles, State of Oregon has a right to the use of
the waters of Mill Creek, for Tract #1, and a Spring for Tract #2;
for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Wasco County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 8, at page 119; that the priority
of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1865

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed One-sixtieth of
a cubic foot per second per acre during the irrigation season from April 1st
to October 1st;

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant
(or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Tract #1.

Four and eight tenths (4.8) acres in the Southeast Quarter of the Northeast
Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$) and One and two tenths (1.2) acres in the Northeast Quarter
of the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty-two (22), Township One (1)
North, Range Twelve (12) East of the Willamette Meridian, being a total of 6
acres.

Tract #2.

Three and five tenths (3.5) acres in the Southeast Quarter of the Northeast
Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty-two (22), Township One (1) North, Range
Twelve (12) East of the Willamette Meridian.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations
contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place
of use herein described.
