of Prineville State of Oregon has a right to the use of the waters of Lytle Creek, a tributary of Crooked River

for the purpose of the irrigation of £3 acres of land, and stock and domestic use,

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Grook County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Record of the Record of the State of Oregon, in Volume 1, at page 449; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from the year 1870,

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed a reasonable amount for domestic and stock use, and 67/100 cubic foot per second for irrigation, the total quentity being limited to four acre feet per acre during each year. The use hereunder shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:

12 acres in the SE of SE; Section Twenty-seven (27): 14 acres in the NE of NE; 9 acres in the NW; of NE; 16 acres in the SW; of NE; 1 acre in the SE; of NE; 1 acre in the SW; of SE; Section Thirty-four (34): all in Township Thirteen (13), South Range Fifteen (15) East of Willamette Meridian, in Crook County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
