CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

has a right to the use of the waters of WALNUT POND (A SUMP), IN THE ROCK CREEK BASIN

for the purpose of IRRIGATION.

The right to the use of these waters has been perfected under Permit G 6470. The date of priority is MAY 28, 1975. The right is limited to not more than 0.810 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well. The well is located as follows:

LOT 4, SW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 19, T 01 N, R 21 E, WM; 900 FEET NORTH & 940 FEET EAST FROM SW CORNER, SECTION 19

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
