CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That ANDREW URQUHART

of The Dalles, State of Oregon has a right to the use of

the waters of Mill Creek and spring

for the purpose of Irrigation, domestic and stock;

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Wasco County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 8, at page 119; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1860

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed One-sixtieth of a cubic foot per second per acre during the irrigation season from April 1st to October 1st, one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second for each one thousand head of stock, and a reasonable amount for domestic purposes; A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Three (3) acres in the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>); Two (2) acres in the Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>) and Five (5) acres in the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>) of Section Eighteen (18), Township One (1) North, Range Thirteen (13) East of the Willamette Meridian, being a total of 10 acres.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
