CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS IS TO CERTIFY, that

GUILD UNITED DITCHES

C/O EDGAR BARTON, BOX 81, UNION, OREGON 97883, has a right to the use of the waters of CATHERINE CREEK, TRIBUTARY OF GRANDE RONDE RIVER for the purpose of IRRIGATION.

The right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for UNION County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 8, at page 1. The date of priority is 1892.

The right is limited to not more than THREE ACRE FEET PER ACRE IN ANY IRRIGATION SEASON DIVERTED AT THE RATE OF NOT TO EXCEED ONE-FORTIETH OF A CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND PER ACRE.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 19, T4S, 40E, WM; 150 FEET SOUTH & 1730 FEET EAST FROM N 1/4 CORNER SECTION 19

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SE1/4 NW1/4 SECTION 19 TOWNSHIP 4 SOUTH, RANGE 40 EAST, WM

MORE EXPLICITLY DESCRIBED AS: BEGINNING 320 FEET SOUTH OF THE SW CORNER, BLOCK 21, TOWN OF UNION, OREGON; THENCE SOUTH 200 FEET; THENCE EAST 210 FEET; THENCE NORTH 200 FEET; THENCE WEST 210 FEET TO THE PLACE OF BEGINNING.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered December 23, 1976 and supersedes certificate 6280, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
