CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That E. W. DRIVER

of Wasco, State of Oregon has a right to the use of the waters of Rock and Gate Creeks, tributaries of White River

for the purpose of Irrigation, Domestic and Stock;

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Wasco County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 7, at page 196; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1887

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed Three acre feet per acre during any irrigation season (with the further limitations contained in paragraph 24 of said decree), one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second for each one thousand head of stock, and a reasonable amount for domestic purposes; A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

One (1) acre in the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) and Four and one tenths (4.1) acres in the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Nineteen (19), Township Four (4) South, Range Thirteen (13) East of the Willamette Meridian, being a total of 5.1 acres;

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
