## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That HAUSER &amp; DAHL

of Tygh Valley, State of Oregon has a right to the use of  
the waters of Badger Creek, a tributary of White River  
for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for  
Wasco County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order  
Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 7, at page 196; that the priority  
of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1872

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an  
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed Three acre feet per  
acre during any irrigation season (with the further limitations contained in  
paragraph 24 of said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant  
(or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Two and five tenths (2.5) acres in the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter  
(SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ); Twenty-one and seven tenths (21.7) acres in the Southeast Quarter of  
the Southwest Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) and Twelve and six tenths (12.6) acres in the South-  
west Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Thirty-two (32), Town-  
ship Three (3) South, Range Thirteen (13) East of the Willamette Meridian; Thirty-  
seven and five tenths (37.5) acres in the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast  
Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ); Thirty-seven and six tenths (37.6) acres in the Northeast Quar-  
ter of the Northwest Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) and Eleven (11) acres in the Northwest  
Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Five (5), Township Four (4)  
South, Range Thirteen (13) East of the Willamette Meridian, being a total of  
122.9 acres.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations  
contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place  
of use herein described.
