CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS IS TO CERTIFY, that J. L. WRIGHT,
of PERDUE, OREGON, has a right to the use of the waters of ST. JOHNS
CREEK AND RAYMOND RESERVOIR AS DESCRIBED IN RESERVOIR PERMIT 260,
CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT RECORDED IN VOLUME 3, PAGE 1999, STATE
RECORD OF WATER RIGHT CERTIFICATES, A TRIBUTARY OF SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER,
for the purpose of IRRIGATING 48.0 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 1836. The date of priority
is DECEMBER 9, 1913. The right is limited to not more than 0.605
CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured
at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE1/4 SW1/4, SECTION 27, TOWNSHIP 30 SOUTH, RANGE
3 WEST, W.M.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be
ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such
right is appurtenant, is as follows:

6.50 ACRES SW1/4 SW1/4
SECTION 27

12.25 ACRES SE1/4 SE1/4
6.50 ACRES SW1/4 SE1/4
8.25 ACRES NW1/4 SE1/4
9.50 ACRES NE1/4 SW1/4
SECTION 28

5.00 ACRES NW1/4 NW1/4
SECTION 34
TOWNSHIP 30 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted
to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed
by certificate 1971, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT
modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director
entered OCTOBER 29, 1985, approving transfer application 5682.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the
status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610
pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water
Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
